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Flying University

Marie Curie was born in Warsaw, Poland, in 1867. Marie was a top student in school. Back then in Poland, women were not allowed to go to university. Marie didn't let that stop her. She joined a secret school called the "Flying University."



This is a photograph of Marie when she was 16.

New Discoveries

Marie wanted to learn more about physics and math. She went to Paris. Women were allowed to go to university there. She earned Masters' degrees in physics and math.

Amazing Fact!

Marie Curie was the first woman to win a Nobel Prize. Nobel Prizes are awards for outstanding work in fields like chemistry, physics, literature, and peace.



This is the Nobel Medal for Physics and Chemistry.

After university, Marie did a lot of science experiments. She and her husband, Pierre, discovered something new. It was something she named "radium." Radium would later be used to treat cancer.



This is a photograph of Marie Curie in her laboratory in 1925.

Nobel Prizes

Marie and Pierre Curie won a *Nobel Prize* in Physics for their work. Sadly, Pierre died a few years later. This upset Marie greatly. She didn't give up. She kept working on their experiments. Later, she won a second Nobel Prize in chemistry.

Marie Curie made huge scientific discoveries. Her work led to doctors being able to identify broken bones with X-rays and to treat cancer. Marie passed on her interest in science to her daughter, Irène. Years later, Irène also won a Nobel Prize in Chemistry.

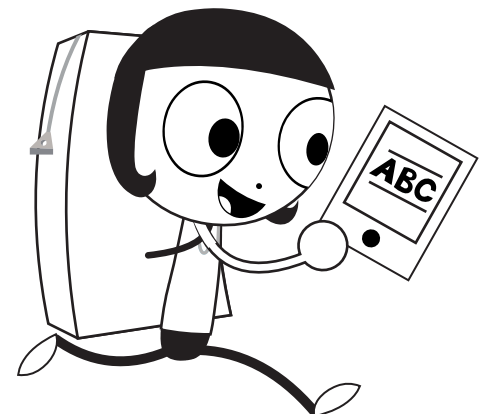

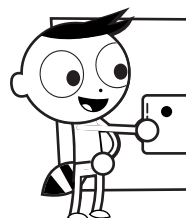
