She didn't give up. She kept working on their experiments. Later, she won a second Nobel Marie and Pierre Curie won a Nobel Prize in Physics for their work. Sadly, Pierre died a few years later. This upset Marie greatly. Prize in chemistry.

Her work led to doctors being able to identify oroken bones with X-rays and to treat cancer. Marie Curie made huge scientific discoveries. Marie passed on her interest in science to her daughter, Irène. Years later, Irène also won a Nobel Prize in Chemistry.

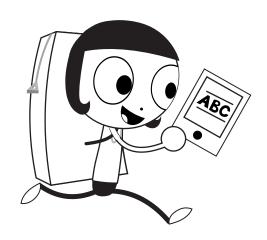
