## ANIMAL GUESSING GAME

**Directions:**  
(for 2 or more players)

**Example:**

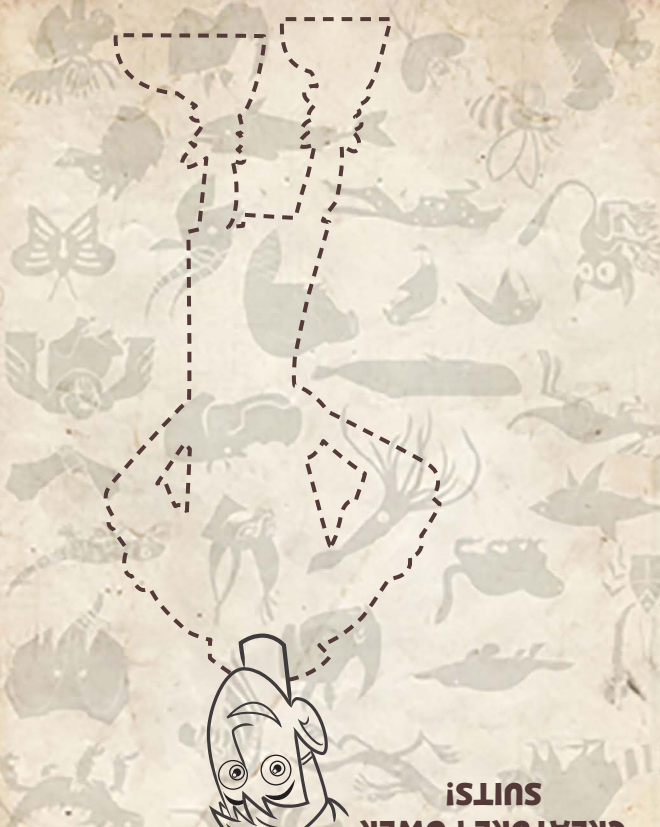
