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Louisiana High School filmmakers to be recognized by the Louisiana Film & Entertainment Association - 2019-2020

Open call to all Louisiana High Schools to submit a film project, up to 5 minutes in length, of any genre...

The LFEA High School Film Competition encourages tomorrow's filmmakers to create films that will inspire audiences through the transformative power of this art form.

LFEA views the short film as an important art form and springboard for young talent. As such, we do not place any formal restrictions on submissions, and will consider all genres and types of short films. Louisiana themed films are encouraged, however. Submissions utilizing original footage, shared footage, photo stills, music, essays, screenplays, original artwork and more are welcome. Submitter must have copy write authorization for all stock or non-original work.

There is no fee for submissions.

Submission Guidelines

- Submissions accepted from Louisiana High Schools only!
- Individual High Schools may submit up to two projects in each category.
- (Documentary, Animated, Picture)
- Submissions must be 5 minutes or less. Films longer than five (5) minutes will not be considered.
- Submissions must be made to the LFEA by providing LFEA with a YouTube video link. Only submissions with complete entry forms will be considered.
- Submission deadline March 31, 2020
- Instructors/Teachers may oversee the production and shall be credited in accordance with their professional title only. *example* "Lincoln High School Drama Instructor John Doe"
- With the exception of on-camera actors/performers/subjects, all persons involved in the production must be a high school student when the film is completed and shall be credited according to the job classification performed, along with the individuals graduating class year.
- *example* "Wardrobe Designer Jane Doe 2021"
- **Only one student may be credited in each category.**
- **The School will be listed for the categories of Best Documentary, Best Animation, Best Picture**
- Only students will be considered for recognition and awards.
- Films which contain nudity, profanity and gratuitous violence will not be considered.
- Submissions will be judged in accordance with the rules and provisions established by LFEA.
- Filmmakers agree that all submitted films may be used by LFEA for educational and outreach activities.

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Judging Procedure

- Five judges will be selected by the LFEA.
- Finalists will be announced by LFEA.
- The winners will be announced at LFEA's Awards Ceremony.
